Guidelines for Paper and/or Panel Proposals

To ensure speedy and affirmative consideration of your proposal, we suggest that:

- You clearly define the topic, scope, approach and significance of your presentation.
- Place your paper within the context of previous literary, cultural, or McCarthy scholarship: how does your work engage, extend, or supersede previous work? In what ways does it constitute an original contribution?

Please provide complete contact information, including email address, mailing address, and academic affiliation.

Individual papers should be readable within 15 to 20 minutes.

Panels should consist of three to four papers on a single or related set of topics, and you should plan for a session time of 90 minutes.

Proposals should be the equivalent of two typewritten double spaced pages in length.

Please specify any audio-visual or IT requirements, if any, at the time you submit your proposal.

IMPORTANT: *Submitting a paper proposal or having your proposal accepted for presentation at the conference does **not** automatically secure your room and board reservation. You must make your own reservations for the conference and accommodations at the University.*
